The Attended Funeral (funeral director's charges only)	£2,295

<i>This is a funeral where family and friends choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at a later date and not at the same time as their burial or cremation</i>

Fees you must pay

For an attended or unattended burial funeral, the **burial fee**.¹

In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee is: **£450**

For a new grave, you will also need to buy the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you will also need to pay for a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees. **to £940**

For an attended cremation funeral, the **cremation fee**.² **£660**

In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation is: **to £1025**

Additional funeral director products and services

This funeral director can supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or they can arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them.

These include:

Additional mileage (price per mile) **£2**

Additional transfers of the deceased person's body (e.g. to their home, to a place of worship etc.) (price per transfer) **£195**

Collection and delivery of ashes **£5**

¹ This fee (which is sometime called the interment or internment fee) is the charge made for digging a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you may also need to pay a Medical Referee (doctor's) Fee.

Terms & Conditions

Financial

1. The company reserves the right to request full or part payment prior to the funeral taking place. Failure to make this payment will result in the cancellation of the funeral. Any services provided up to this point will be charged. We accept payment by cash, cheque or bank transfer. Our bank details are Account Number 22208865 (HSBC Bank) Sort Code 40 18 17. Please note that we do not accept payment by any form of debit or credit card. All clients not residing in the UK will be required to make full payment prior to the funeral taking place.
2. The Funeral Account is due for payment within 14 days of the date of Account. In default of such payment the Company shall be entitled to charge interest on a daily basis (both before and after any judgement) on the amount outstanding at the rate of five percent above Barclays Bank plc base rate until payment in full is made.
3. The company reserves the right to recover from the client on an indemnity basis (in addition to the interest referred to above) any legal fees and/or accountancy or agency charges incurred in the collection of any monies not paid by the due day for payment.
4. The Estimate overleaf is only an indication of the charges likely to be incurred on the basis of the information and details known at the date of the Estimate. Whilst every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of the Estimate the charges are liable to alteration particularly in the circumstances of a change in the rates or charges of any third parties. The Company enters into the contract to provide the funeral strictly on this basis and the client agrees to pay the full amount of the Funeral Account which will be based on the Estimate, but with any alterations which may have been required, to reflect any change in circumstances.

Memorials

5. The Company does not accept responsibility for any loss of or damage to any memorial removed; any memorials stored by the Company until replacement are stored entirely at the client's risk and are not insured by the Company.
6. Where no instructions for an additional inscription and/or the replacement of any memorial have been received within 5 years after the date of the funeral the client will be deemed to have instructed the Company to destroy the memorial.

Cremated Remains

7. Where the company has been instructed to temporarily hold cremated remains and no further instructions have been received within 5 years after the date of the funeral the client will be deemed to have instructed the Company to return the cremated remains to the crematoria for disposal. After 13 months of holding the cremated a storage charge of £10.00 a month will be issued unless a prior agreement has been made.

Data Protection

8. All personal information that we may collect (including, but not limited to, your name and address) will be collected, used and held in accordance with all Data Protection Laws.
9. In order to provide our services to you, we may pass on your personal information to celebrants, clergy, church officials, cemeteries and crematoria. We will not pass on your personal information to any other third parties without first obtaining your express permission.
10. We may also use your personal data to pass on information to you about our funeral plans. If you don't wish to receive this information, please inform our staff.
11. The time date and location details of the funeral ceremony will be deemed to be in the public domain. As such all enquiries requesting this information will be answered. In signing this contract, I give my permission for the company to pass on this information and place it on our website and our partners funeralzone.co.uk. Please inform our staff if you would prefer this information to be kept private.

Cancellation

12. You have the right to cancel this contract if you so wish. This right can be exercised by sending or taking a written cancellation notice to the company. Payment will be required for any goods or services provided up to the point when the cancellation notice has been received by the company.

Local Authority Fines

13. The company will make every practical effort to ensure the funeral runs on time. If a service starts late or over runs and the local authority issue a fine this will be passed on to you.
